Call for Applications: 2010-11 China Scholarship Council-Georgetown University Post-Doctoral Fellowship

The China Scholarship Council – Georgetown University Post-Doctoral Fellowship Program is pleased to announce a call for applications. The Program was established in May 2006 to support academic and research exchange between Georgetown and leading Chinese universities. Fields of the post-doctoral research include natural sciences, physical, life and health sciences, among others. Since the past three rounds, twenty-two Chinese scholars have been granted this fellowship. Each fellowship offers an annual stipend of no less than USD \$30,000; in addition, fellows will have an opportunity to work with leading experts in their chosen fields. The duration of the fellowship is 12-24 months. The Fellowship also includes round-trip airfare, visa application fees, work space at Georgetown, and access to university research facilities. This fellowship is administered jointly by the China Scholarship Council and Georgetown University. Applicants must apply through cscfellowship@georgetown.edu.

Eligible candidates will:

- Have received a PhD degree from a Chinese university or institution by March 20, 2010
- Be permanently employed at a university or research institute in China (Candidates who are currently on a temporary post-doctoral contract with a Chinese university or research institute will not be eligible.)
- Possess high-level English-language skills
- Present a compelling and explicit statement of interest in Georgetown research and teaching projects
- Be assessed on the originality of their scholarship and the high quality of their academic record
- Have returned to China for at least five years if they have previously received an award from the China Scholarship Council
